

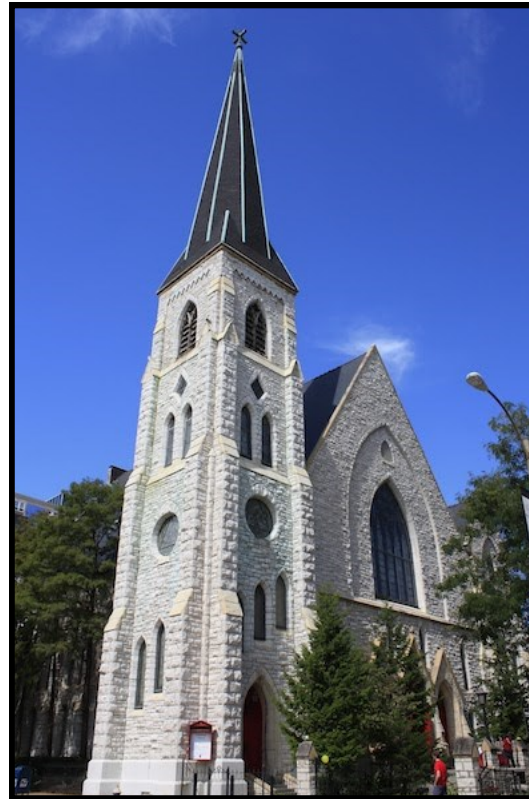
Centenary Mission House Experience

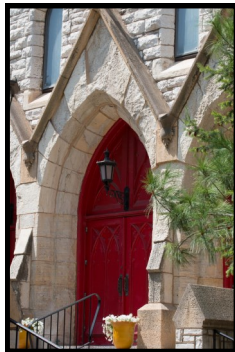

Cost

We require a non-refundable \$100 deposit to save your dates and we will reserve up to one year in advance. The suggested donation of \$20/person/night is appreciated.

Requirements

Groups must have a 1:5 ratio of adult to youth and youth must be of high school age.
